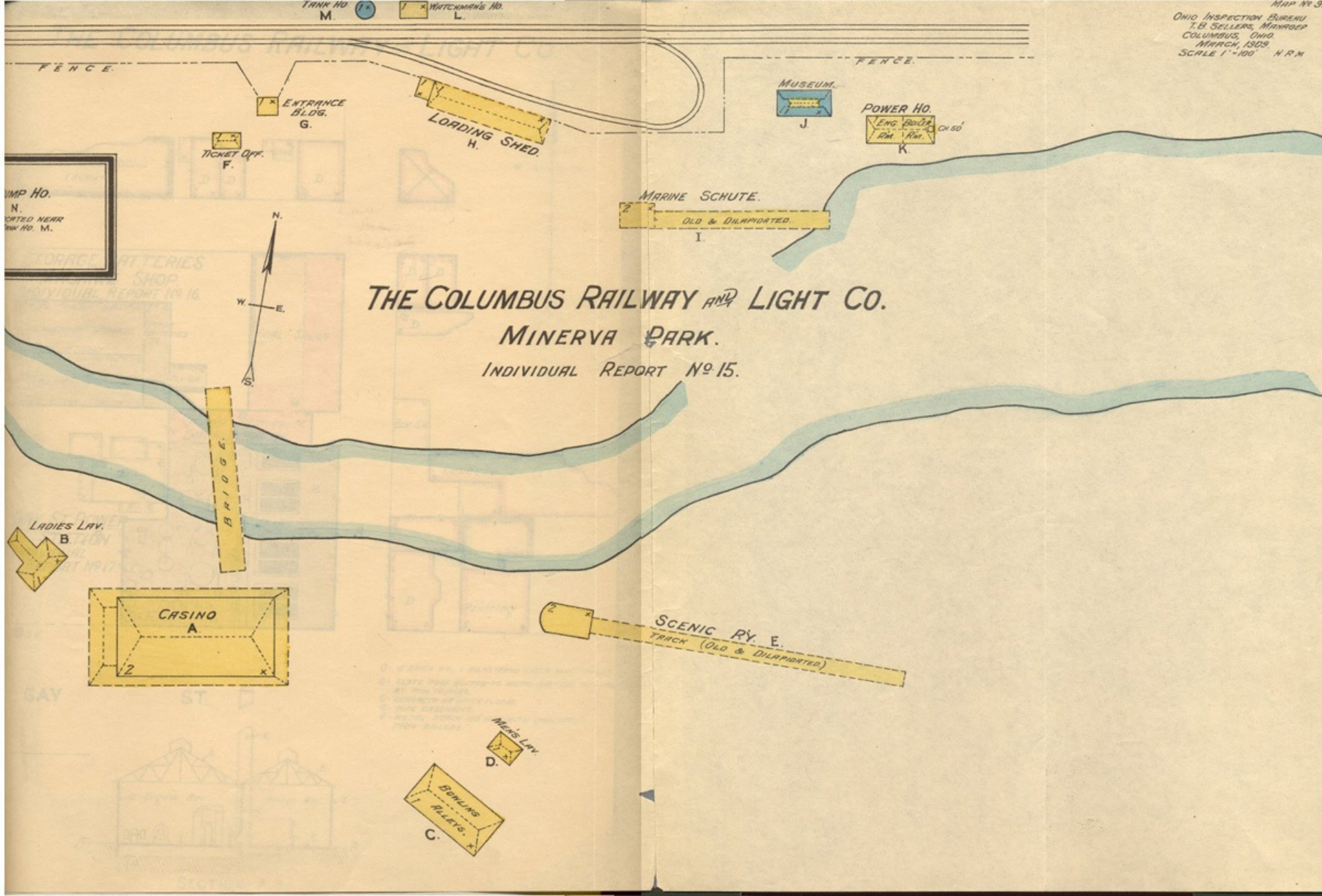

#### SUMMARY.

A group of park buildings and mostly of frame construction with areas and location indicated on map. A portion of the buildings are quite old and dilapidated. The park has not proved to be a popular one and the buildings have not been well kept up, but same are so located as to not greatly expose each other. The principal building, the Casino, has a hand chemical extinguisher and a watchman is kept on duty at the grounds Winter & Summer. Only three of the buildings, the Casino, the Ladies Lavatory and the Power House Building are insured at this time under separate form, ordinary policy. Part of the buildings are so badly dilapidated they could hardly be considered as insurable.
