

Locomotive Over Turns at Station

(Columbus Dispatch, October 15, 1929)

Shortly after the Baltimore & Ohio train No. 133, left Union station at 3:05pm Monday, bound for Cincinnati, a broken rear truck of the engine tender derailed the engine, which turned over and ploughed three feet into the road bed.

C.C. Cummings, engineer, and A. E. Fiercoete, fireman, both of Newark, jumped and escaped injury. None of the passenger cars left the rails, because of the slow speed of the train. The accident occurred approximately 100 yards west of the station.
