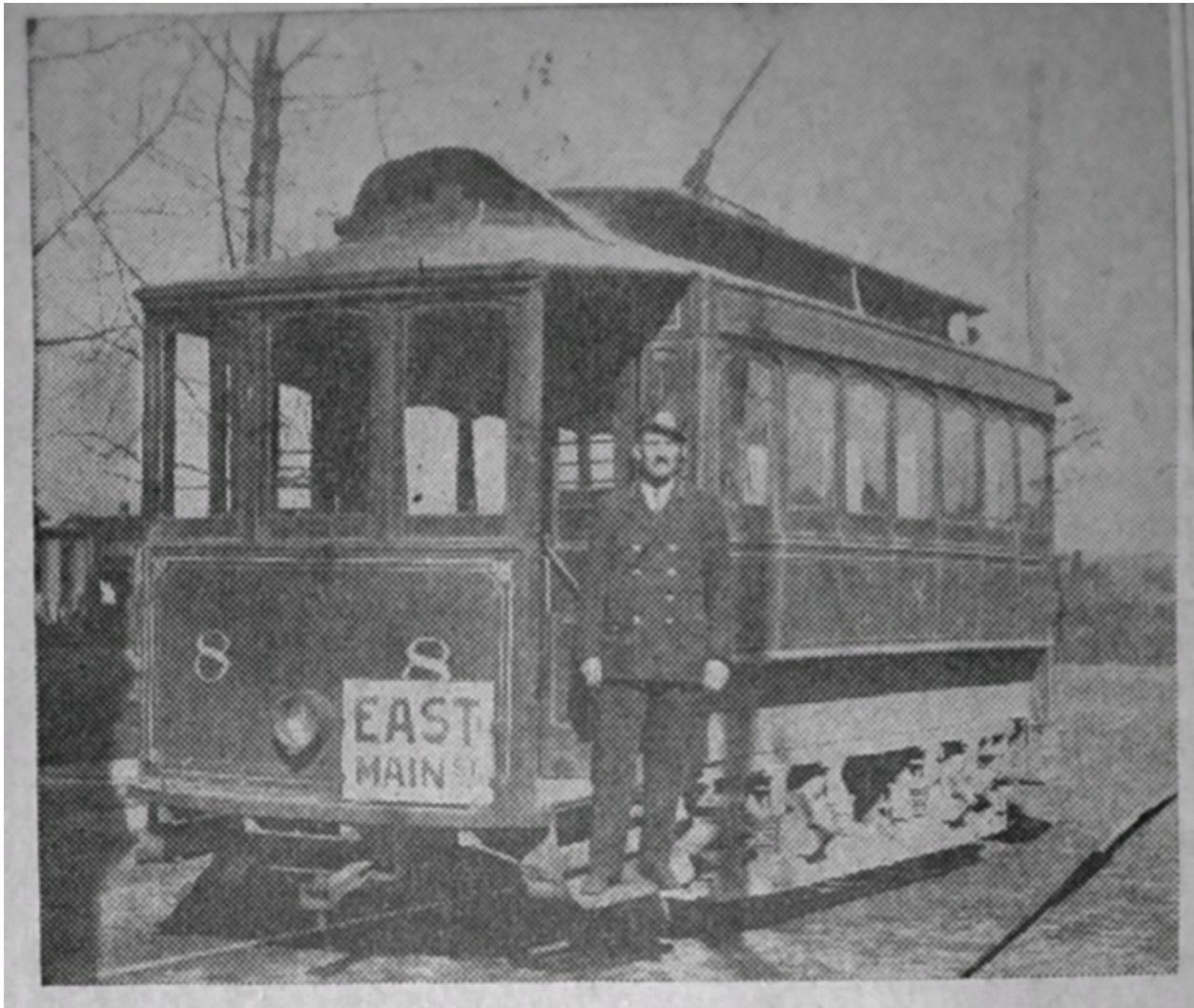


VETERAN MOTORMAN IN 1910
