

SNAKES ALIVE!

Pittsburg, Pa. April 16, 1952 2:00 AM

Conductor of No. 66 of April 15th, Engine 5828A/??19A with 12 cars (Conductor J.M.Mackey, Enginmen L.J.Hallman; reported on arrival at Altona:

In vicinity of Latrobe Pa., Pittsburgh Division; the dining car steward when about to go to bed ion 9th car in train Car 663 Slpr JBarney, St.Louis/New York car reported to train crew he observed a snake in the car.

Train crew made examination found and killed two snakes about 2 ½ ft long and one other snake about 15 inches long. Were unable to identify kind of snakes but described them as being black with red belly and red spot on back of head.

No personal injuries.
