We recently lost two of our long time chapter members, Bert Kram and Ron Widman. Both had been in ill health for some time, however, we were honored to have both of them present at our last chapter meeting on 8 September. They were both dedicated members of our chapter, and will be missed!

Bert Kram passed away on 20 September. He was a highly regarded attorney with a local firm and did much work on railroad related litigation. He was a rail fan from an early age and was a member of the PRR T&HS, Nickel Plate Historical & Technical Society, and The C&O Historical Society. Bert was a contributor to our chapter through an article on railroad operations in his hometown, Frankfort, Indiana, and was a staff member when we hosted the annual meeting of the PRR T&HS in 2011.

Ron Widman passed away on 3 October. He was a charter member of the Lines West–Buckeye Region Chapter. He served as editor of the chapter newsletter and was an author of historical newspaper articles, including the Pennsylvania Railroad. He was a U.S. Army veteran with service in Korea and Viet Nam. Ron was a talented photographer and following his military service he worked as a news cameraman/film editor/film archivist at WBNS-TV. During that time he was a recipient of an Emmy award and two Telly awards.
